Warranty Terms

What does the warranty cover?

We'll cover you against unexpected or premature failure of covered parts that occur within the warranty period and odometer limit.

N.B. This warranty is not transferable to anyone else.

What costs are covered?

Provided the defect has occurred within the stated warranty limits, County will cover the cost of the repair up to the **Claim Limit** (where the Manufacturer's warranty period has expired), providing the vehicle is returned with this original Certificate to any County depot (or to a manufacturer-approved dealer if the Vehicle is still within the manufacturer's warranty period and odometer limits).

What costs are not covered?

Remember that the purpose of our warranty is only to cover defects that may have arisen prematurely. We can't cover problems arising from:

- Failure to follow instructions contained in the vehicle's operating manual or maintenance guides.
- Failure to have the vehicle maintained and serviced correctly and at the required intervals as defined by the manufacturer.
- Repairs or non-routine service work by an unauthorised garage.
- The fitting of unapproved parts, any additional equipment or bodywork.
- Using or driving the vehicle outside the instructions outlined in the driver's handbook.
- Damage caused by excessive speed.
- Not following advice provided by the vehicle's information system or dashboard warning lights.
- Exceeding gross vehicle weights, axle loads and payload capacity.
- Normal wear and tear on parts, including friction and consumable items such as oil and lubricants, filters, brake pads, clutch materials, wiper blades, tyres, some exhaust components and shock absorbers (this list is not exhaustive).
- External events including environmental issues such as storms and floods, accident damage, salt corrosion, civil unrest or vandalism.
- Any incidental costs arising from the defect; costs such as loss of use and rental charges, telephone calls, other travel or accommodation expenses, time or inconvenience or loss of business earnings.
- Costs relating to routine servicing and maintenance, accident damage and replacing normal wear and tear items.

Parts Excluded

1. Any service parts periodically replaced during the manufacturer's recommended servicing of the Vehicle. This includes the replacement of any camshaft timing belt, tensioner or any associated repair cost where it cannot be shown within the Vehicle's service record that the correct servicing of the camshaft belt and tensioner has been carried out.
2. All non-mechanical and non-electrical parts.
3. Worn out parts.
4. The repair or replacement of any part not previously authorised in writing by County.
5. Any part that has not suffered a breakdown or failure but which is recommended for replacement.
6. Any items fitted to your Vehicle after the date of manufacture such as: roof racks, ply lining, tow bars, ladders etc. (this list is not exhaustive).
7. Any part which has been in any way modified or is not to the manufacturer's approved specification.
8. Any part damaged due to it being forced or operated incorrectly.
9. Any part which is rusty, corroded or seized-up (such as catalytic converters), parts blocked up with carbon (for example valves and filters).
10. Any part which has suffered breakdown or failure due to flooding or water ingress, de-lamination, condensation, freezing, burning, melting; insufficient or incorrect coolant, lubricant or fuel; blockage due to swarf or sludge.
11. Any part which has suffered a breakdown or failure due to wear and tear due to a lack of or incorrect servicing, oil or coolant leak, negligence, neglect, misuse, broken by you, criminal damage, theft or attempted theft, accident.
12. Parts covered by the vehicle manufacturer's warranty period.
